## Words of Hope - Pastor Rhoda Klein Miller



This month we are considering the Lord's Prayer as a framework for finding freedom. In Luke 11:3, Jesus teaches something that is still counter-cultural and challenging to accept: total dependence on God for all of our needs. Jesus explains the full extent of what such absolute trust in God's provision looks like in Mat 6:25-34.

The call to live a God-dependent life is echoed throughout Scripture. We witness the Israelites wander the wilderness, reliant on God for food, water, warmth, and protection (Deut. 2:7). Trust in God's provision is the very essence of King David's most famous psalm: "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want" (Psalm 23:1). The understanding "God will meet all our needs" is further reaffirmed by Paul in his letter to the church at Philippi (Phil 4: 11-19). Still, we struggle to submit our self-sufficiency. In our quest for security, we have a tendency to second-guess God. God is patient and forgives our doubts. Ultimately though, He wants us to forego the "rat race" and find freedom in contentment with what He provides.
